### Aims and objectives

The Adapt Northern Heritage Forum is a group of national and regional competent authorities in the field of cultural heritage, interested in the sustainable use of the historic environment in the context of an environmentally changing climate.



#### The Forum focusses on

- historic places in northerly world regions, including cultural heritage in the Arctic and of northern indigenous communities
- practical policy development and support of local and regional stakeholders concerned with historic environment conservation



#### The Forum aims at

- enabling knowledge exchange and networking between higher-level organisation at international and national level
- supporting the use and enhancement of the outputs of the Interreg NPA project Adapt Northern Heritage, especially regarding climate-related risk management
- lobbying for international actions to adapt historic places to the impacts of climate change, e.g. engagement with Arctic Council, Council of Europe, European Union, ICOMOS, ICCROM and UNESCO



#### The Forum intends to

- hold an annual themed meeting, either digitally or in the real world
- inform by email newsletters, quarterly or twice-yearly
- form an organising committee to meet at least digitally twice-yearly
- conduct other activities as agreed and funded by its members
